# PURPOSE OF EVALUATION

- ✓ To analyze the implementation in Bulgaria and first results
- ✓ To increase participation and success rate

Data collection consisted of document analyses, stakeholders feedback and information from 100 projects with 260 participants.

# MAIN CHALLENGES



- ✓ Co-financing
- ✓ Lack of resources
- ✓ Finding partners



**Main sources of information** – Funding and Tenders, Digital Europe’s website, Ministry of Transport and Communication’s website

38.4 % of the Bulgarian organisations participating in the Digital Europe Programme and 36 % of the submitted proposals had received funds from the Digital Europe programme

**Main obstacles:**

- ✓ the proposals align well with most of the objectives outlined in the calls. However, the description lacks the requisite depth to substantiate how these objectives will be achieved;
- ✓ the implementation plan is not sound and of high quality;
- ✓ unbalanced consortium;
- ✓ the identified risks in the proposal are confined in scope;
- ✓ the impact of the project is not clearly explained and lacks sufficient detail

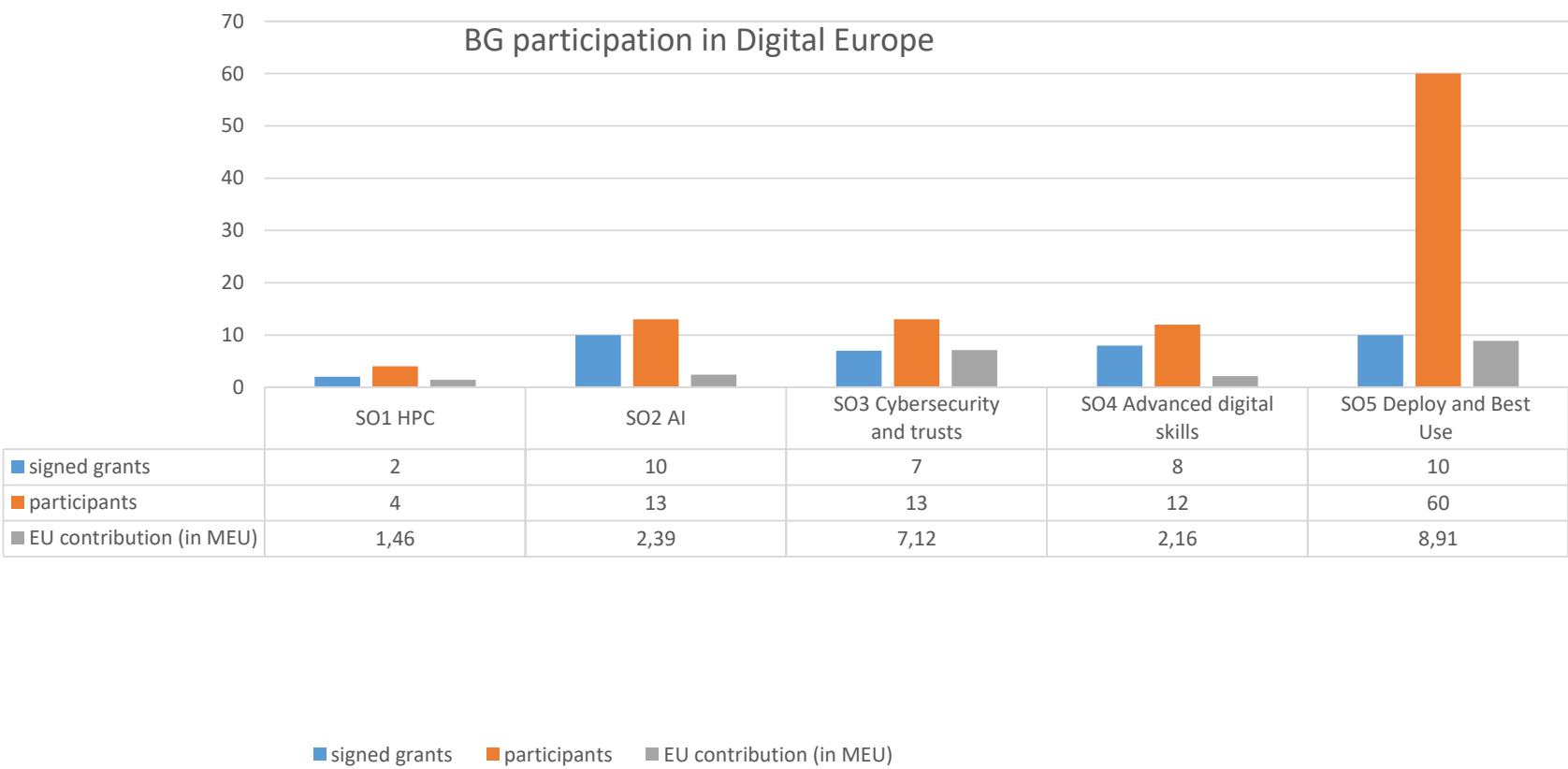


# BULGARIAN PARTICIPATION

- ✓ **Success rate:** 34.45%
- ✓ **Signed grants:** 38
- ✓ **Coordinators:** 8
- ✓ **Participations:** 104
- ✓ **Unique participants:** 85
- ✓ **Main SOs:** SO 3, SO 5
- ✓ **Total costs:** 41.06 MEUR
- ✓ **EU contribution:** 22.14 MEUR

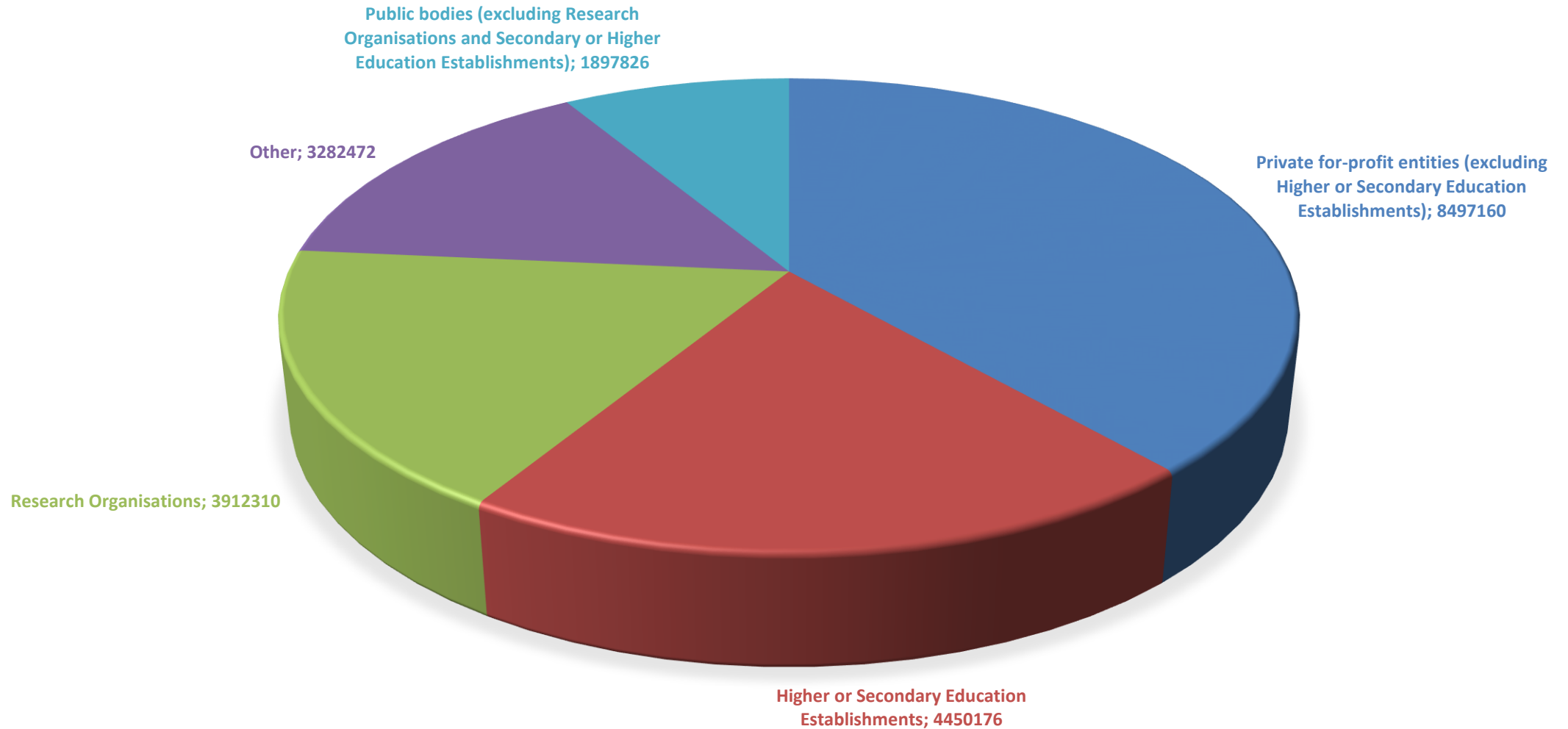


# BG PARTICIPATION/SOs



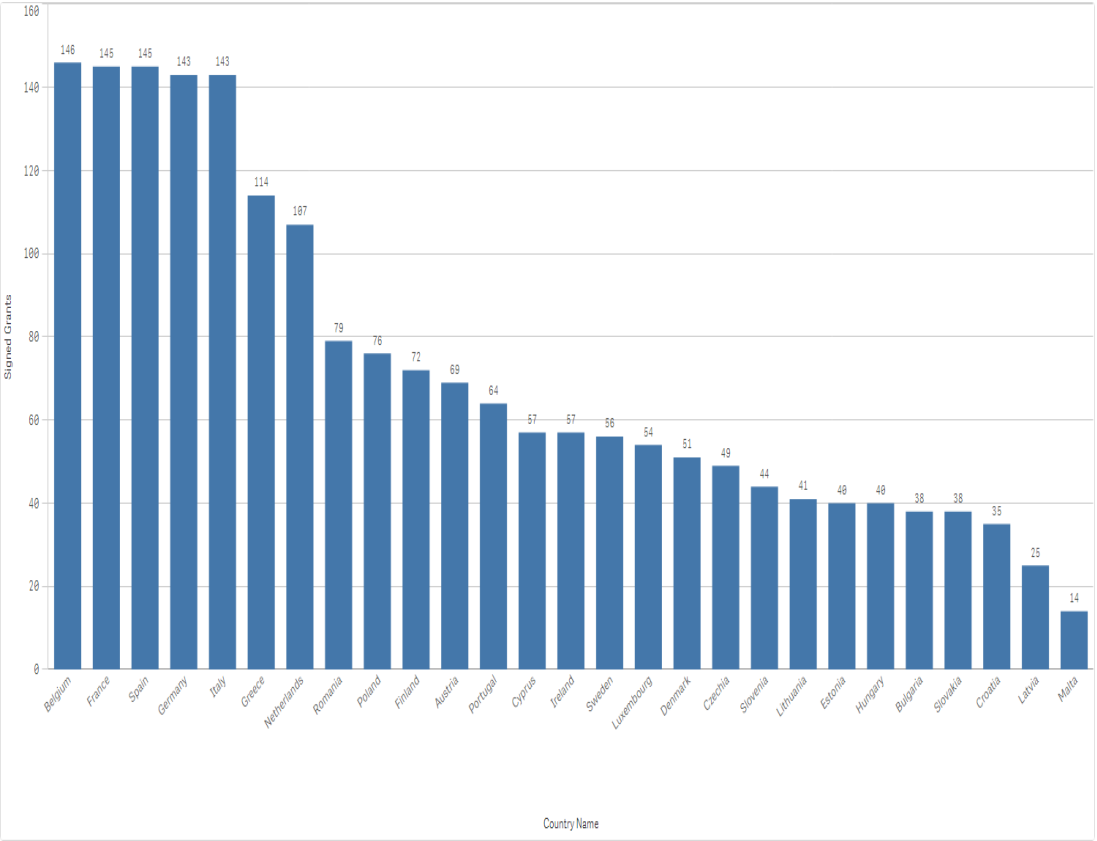


# EU Contribution (EUR)/Organisation type

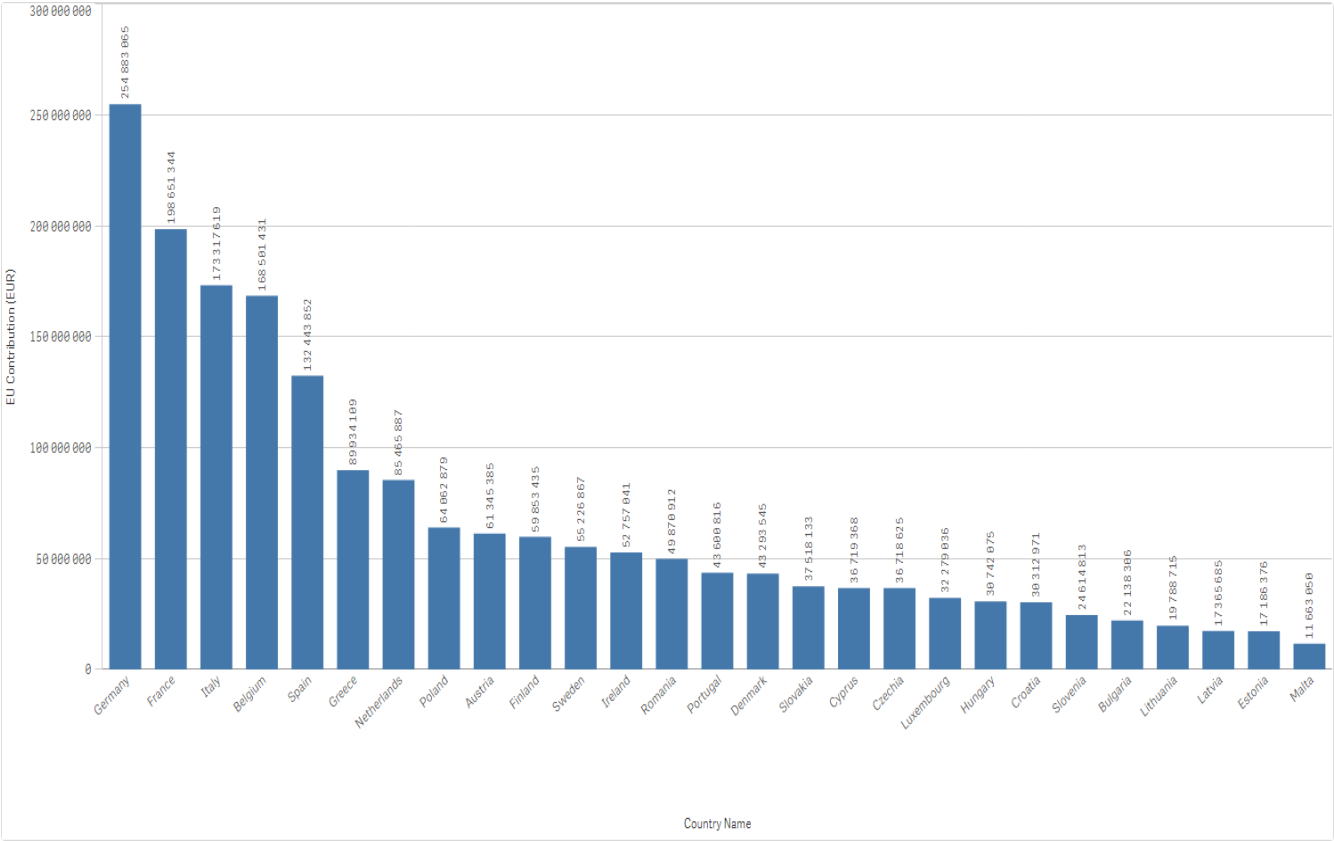




# Signed grants/MSs

# RECOMMENDATIONS

- ✓ Raise Awareness and Improve Communication: Organize more info sessions, webinars and promotional materials, targeting specific sectors and stakeholders, share success stories of successful projects to encourage participation;
- ✓ Strengthen the role of National Contact Points (NCPs);
- ✓ Ensuring national co-financing for some actions;
- ✓ Collect feedback: Regularly survey participants to identify barriers and improve processes.
