### **PURPOSE OF EVALUATION**

 $\checkmark$  To analyze the implementation in Bulgaria and first results

 $\checkmark$  To increase participation and success rate

Data collection consisted of document analyses, stakeholders feedback and information from 100 projects with 260 participants.



### MAIN CHALLENGES

- Co-financingLack of resources
- ✓ Finding partners



Main sources of information – Funding and Tenders, Digital Europe's website, Ministry of Transport and Communication's website

38.4 % of the Bulgarian organisations participating in the Digital Europe Programme and 36 % of the submitted proposals had received funds from the Digital Europe programme

#### Main obstacles:

- ✓ the proposals align well with most of the objectives outlined in the calls. However, the description lacks the requisite depth to substantiate how these objectives will be achieved;
- ✓ the implementation plan is not sound and of high quality;
- ✓ unbalanced consortium;
- $\checkmark$  the identified risks in the proposal are confined in scope;
- $\checkmark$  the impact of the project is not clearly explained and lacks sufficient detail






- ✓ EU contribution: 22.14 MEUR


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

- ✓ Collect feedback: Regularly survey participants to identify barriers and improve processes.
